HOW TO LIVE THE BLESSED LIFE (1) 2018-01-21

MATTHEW 5:1-11

- In this passage of scripture, Jesus is describing one person, that has these character traits.
- Jesus is essentially saying that a person is happy, if they have these traits.
- This is Jesus, teaching us how to be, "happy".
- It would be safe to replace the word <u>blessed</u> with the word <u>happy</u>.

MATTHEW 5:3 "Blessed are the **poor in spirit**, for **theirs** is the **kingdom of heaven**

- Jesus uses the words *poor in spirit*. What does this phrase mean?
- 1. **Poor in spirit** means that we realize that without Jesus, the human spirit is depraved, broken, corrupt, desperately wicked: see **IEREMIAH 17:9** "The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked; who can know it?
- As long as we think we're OK without Jesus, we're not poor in spirit.
- Secular humanism teaches that all human beings are inherently good. This is not what the Bible teaches.
- 2. *Poor in sprit* means not only acknowledging our need for Jesus for salvation but also that we need the *mind of the Spirit*:

ROMANS 8:27 Now He who searches the hearts knows what the *mind of the Spirit* is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

ROMANS 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the *renewing of your mind*, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God **1 CORINTHIANS 2:16(b)** But we have the mind of Christ

PHILIPPIANS 2:5 Let this *mind* be in you which was also in Christ Jesus

- 3. *Poor in spirit* means that I'm not only willing to learn about Jesus but that I'm willing to let Jesus change my heart.
- So many people have learnt so much about Jesus and the Bible but have never let Jesus change their hearts, through the power of His Holy Spirit
- These people have learnt so much and have become educated beyond their level of obedience: **2 TIMOTHY 3:7** always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.
- This hunger for knowledge only feeds the spirit of religion and empowers it to have a form of godliness, while denying it's power:
- **2 TIMOTHY 3:5** having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away
- 4. Jesus declares that "*theirs*" is the Kingdom of heaven. He specifies that His Kingdom belongs to those who are *poor in spirit*. This means that if we're not poor in spirit, the Kingdom of heaven is not ours!!!
- 5. The *poor in spirit* own the *Kingdom of Heaven*. The Kingdom of heaven is: **ROMANS 14:17** for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but *righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit*.
