<u>HEBREWS 12:14</u> Pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord

LEVITICUS 11:45 For I am the LORD who brings you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God. **You shall therefore be holy, for I am holy**.

- Recap: last week we discussed a definition of holiness, that holiness means facing our toughest crisis of faith, and overcoming it.
- This week, we'll consider the concept, that <u>HOLINESS MEANS LIVING A LIFESTYLE</u> OF PRAYER

1 THESSALONIANS 5:17

(NKJV) pray without ceasing (MSG) pray all the time (NLTSE) Never stop praying.

- Prayer is more a case of being with someone, than it is a case of doing something
- · Prayer is not necessarily doing something but rather it's mindset or attitude
- Holiness is living in the realization that Jesus Christ lives inside you:

<u>COLOSSIANS 1:27(MSG)</u> God wanted everyone, not just Jews, to know this rich and glorious secret inside and out, regardless of their background, regardless of their religious standing. The mystery in a nutshell is just this: <u>Christ is in you</u>, therefore you can look forward to sharing in God's glory. It's that simple. That is the substance of our message.

<u>JOHN 14:23</u> Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him

JOHN 15:1-8 (MSG)

• The secret of praying is praying in secret:

MATTHEW 6:1-8

Prayerfulness will keep the world out of us
